### ADDRESS FROM THE REVEREND

Dear friends,

*Reading Luke 24 1.*

"Christ is risen: He is risen indeed, Hallelujah!" Those are the words of greeting on Easter morning. They may well be very familiar to us all, almost too familiar. Those words encapsulate the single greatest event of history – the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. Those words speak of the single greatest hope for mankind – the hope of sins forgiven, death defeated and the resurrection to new life. The resurrection of Jesus is key to our present as well as our future hope. Christ is alive and today sits at the right hand of God the Father interceding for us – I John 2.1.

The resurrected Christ is able to save those who put their trust in Him (Hebrews 7.25). Alive, He awaits the appointed time to come again and to take us to be with Him, to reunite us with all the believers in Christ and to live with Him forever (I Thess.4.13-18). The resurrected Christ living in us enables us to live lives transformed by the Holy Spirit. Where once we lived lives which spoke of our sinful state now we are enabled to live godly lives to the glory of God. Jesus was raised from the dead. He is alive today and the transformed lives of Christians should be a powerful witness to the resurrection.

Jesus lives! Therefore live a resurrection life.
